



## International Rowing Tournament Ferdinand Martinengo Memorial 2007

**October 6<sup>th</sup> 2007**

**Start** – Orth an der Donau

**Finish** – Bratislava/Petrzalka

On October 6<sup>th</sup> 2007 the 3<sup>rd</sup> Eights-boat-race Ferdinand Martinengo Memorial – FMM - will take place on the river Danube. By choosing the way from Orth an der Donau to Bratislava the Ferdinand Martinengo Association, the Slovak Rowing Association and the Municipality of Bratislava, Old Town is continuing a new tradition of sport and cultural event across borders in an European sense. The boat-race is for heavyweight eights (i.e., for eight rowers with a cox steering, and no restrictions on weight). The race is rowed down stream.

**The START of the Rowing Tournament is at 2 o'clock p.m. at the left side of the Danube, in Orth an der Donau – Boat center, River-km 1903, the site of the restaurant 'Humers Uferhaus', the centre of the Austrian National Park 'Donau-Auen'.**

**The FINISH of the boat race in Bratislava is on the right side of the river Danube in Petrzalka, River-km 1868. The first boats will arrive approximately at 15:45 p.m.**

**Registration for the FMM boat race until September 3rd 2007 to the Slovak Rowing Association.** Additionally for registration: List of names, birth data, address, club, passport number (incl. date of expiration).

**Registration for accommodation until September 3rd 2007 to the Slovak Rowing Association.** All expenditures for accommodation will be covered by the Ferdinand Martinengo Association (Expenditures for each team covers 10 persons)
